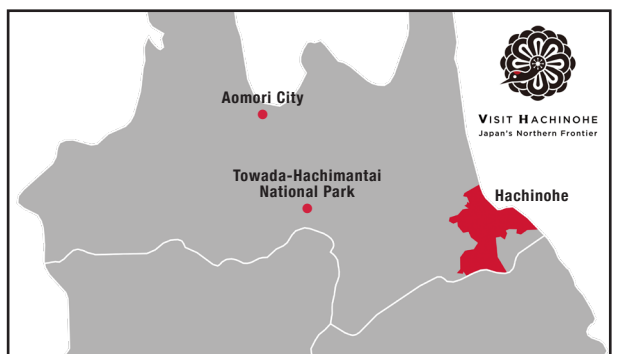

Hachinohe makes a great stop on the way from Tokyo to discovering northern Japan



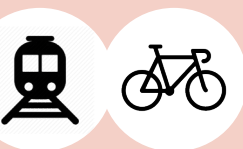
### BY PLANE

### BY TRAIN

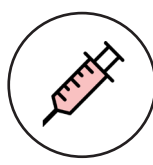
Tokyo - Hachinohe 2hrs 45

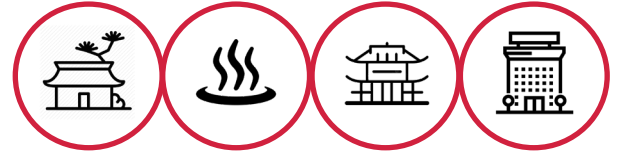
